

Avadex use in Countryside Stewardship schemes

Avadex Factor and Avadex Excel 15G are the only pre-emergence herbicides permitted for use in the following Mid- and High-tier Countryside Stewardship scheme options:



- AB7 Whole Crop Cereals
- AB10 Unharvested Cereal Headlands
- AB14 Harvested Low Input Cereals

The main focus for Avadex (tri-allate) use in these scheme options is for the control of annual grasses, especially black-grass and wild-oats.

Application rates, label conditions etc. are unchanged from use in 'standard' situations.

For post-emergence weed control in these scheme options, only four other active ingredients are permitted: amidosulfuron, clodinafop-propargyl, fenoxaprop-p-ethyl and pinoxaden.
